



Capital Region of Denmark's Psychiatry – Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Center in Glostrup

In connection with the establishment of single rooms with their own shower and toilet, as well as new administration, the Children and Adolescent Psychiatric Center in Glostrup will be rebuilding and changing the existing buildings, and a total of 6 smaller extensions will be built. In connection with the establishment of a new emergency function and administration at the Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Center in Glostrup, a thorough rebuilding of building 63 and a small extension will be carried out.

In the adjoining buildings, changes are made to the layout and function- adapted to the new emergency function and for the establishment of single rooms with their own toilet and shower.

The center examines and treats mentally ill children and young people aged 0-17. The center receives approx. 1600 references.

The majority of patients are treated outpatient with approx. 12,000 outpatient visits per year. The center has a total of 28 day and night places and 22 day places.

The consultancy work includes engineering consultancy in connection with outline proposals, project proposals, authority project, authority processing, main project and preparation of tender material, holding of tenders, tender evaluation, construction management and supervision, submission and holding of 1 year review.
